Terms of Use / Agreement

1. Battery Rescue has the exclusive collection rights over the used lead acid batteries that are collected in the BTS Container.
2. Battery Rescue (or a contractor acting on its behalf) will endeavour to promptly (but in any case, within 7 days) collect the full Container from the Customer and deliver at the same time an empty exchange Container.
3. Battery Rescue (or its contractor) will transport the collected batteries in accordance with the Australian Code for Transportation of Dangerous Goods, WA Controlled Waste Regulations and WA Road Transport Laws.
4. Payment for the batteries will be made to the Customer via EFT to the Customer's bank account within 14 days of any collection.
5. The amount paid per kg may vary due to fluctuations in the LME price for Lead. In the spirit of transparency, Battery Rescue will publish on its webpage batteryrescue.com.au/prices, its current price schedule.
6. Payment for the first used lead acid battery collection will not be made, as this will serve as an (Establishment Fee) for the BTS Container and associated Used Battery Collection Service.
7. Except in relation to fair wear and tear, the Customer remains responsible and liable to Battery Rescue for any significant damage or loss of a Container within its possession.
8. If a collection of a full BTS Container (>900kg) is not performed in any 12-month period, a payment of \$250 plus GST will be charged.
